

# DEVELOPING A GROWTH MINDSET CULTURE IN SCHOOLS (Primary and Secondary)



## Who is this programme for?

For Primary and Secondary Headteachers, Senior and Middle Leaders, KS1 to KS5 teachers, and anyone with a keen interest in developing a growth mindset culture within their school or classroom.
